# PECSAA

## League Rules and Regulations

### I. Principles and Purpose

- A.** The principles of the PECSAA league are to foster Christian ideals and sportsmanship among its member schools, teams, and participants.
- B.** To recognize the youth participant as an individual with unique abilities and limitations with every precaution taken to ensure that each is developed to their highest potential.
- C.** The purpose of the PECSAA league is to promote the teaching of basic skills, development of individual talents, and teamwork. In addition, provide the league's participants and supporters the opportunity to enjoy the best possible recreation advantages and atmosphere.

### II. League Director

**A.** A League Director shall be elected from the Athletic Director of the participating school, alternating between cities in which schools are located. The League Director will serve without pay and his/her duties include:

1. Appointment of a scheduling chairman to make up league schedules to assure equitable scheduling of all teams. The schedule will include Girls Junior Varsity, Boys Junior Varsity, Girls Varsity, and Boys Varsity Basketball games as well as Junior Varsity and Varsity Volleyball, Soccer, Cross Country, Golf, and Track.
2. The League Director shall have the authority to appoint other committee chairman as is necessary.
3. He/She shall select and purchase appropriate trophies and awards and determine the amount of money to be assessed to each league member to cover the cost.
4. He/She shall record and tabulate results of the Sportsmanship Trophies.
5. The League Director shall act as final arbitrator in all questions of dispute among league members.

6. The League Director shall be responsible for calling the first league meeting for the upcoming school year.
7. The League Director shall consult with coaches and Athletic Directors on a continuing basis for efficient league operation.
8. Athletic Directors can be a bench coach during any game as long as they have an assistant athletic director designated to fulfill his position during the game situation.

**III. Assistant League Director**

**A.** An Assistant League Director will be elected each year to serve without pay and to assist the League Director in whatever way serves the mutual convenience of both and best interests of the League.

**IV. Finances**

**A.** Each school is assessed \$350.00 by the 1st of August. Payment must be made to the school whose League Director is responsible for that school year.

**B.** The League Director shall make an accounting to the Athletic Directors for all expenditures.

**V. Trophies**

**A.** First, Second, and Third place Basketball, Volleyball, Golf, and Track League Tournament Trophies: Traveling trophies will be awarded to the teams placing first, second, and third in the Tournament. The Basketball teams include all four - Girls Junior Varsity, Boys Junior Varsity, Girls Varsity, and Boys

Varsity. Volleyball (Junior Varsity and Varsity), Kickball, Golf, and Track are Co-ed teams. (Only one team each for kickball and track.)

### **VI. Academic Policy**

**A.** All athletes must maintain an overall "C" each nine-week period and no "F" in any subject during the school year.

### **VI. Protocol**

**A.** If a dispute or problem arises in the athletic realm the following protocol that must be followed: The Athletic Director must be notified. If they are not available, the assistant Athletic Director must be notified. If neither is available, a coach of the school may be approached to handle the problem.
